A FLEXIBLE APARTMENT CONCEPT IN THE FORM OF A GIANT SWISS-ARMY KNIFE. THE BLADES OF THE KNIFE HAVE BEEN REPLACED BY THE FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF LUXURIOUS MODERN LIVING.

RATHER THAN USING THE PERIMETER WALLS OF A PARTICULAR SPACE TO DEFINE THE ARCHITECTURE, ALL FUNCTIONS ARE GROUPED INTO A SINGLE UNIT THAT COULD BE DEPLOYED ANYWHERE, SUCH AS REDUNDANT OFFICE SPACE.

PRIMARY FUNCTIONS ARE GROUPED AROUND FOUR CORNER PIVOTS; LIVING, EATING, WASHING AND SLEEPING. TELESCOPIC 'TOOTHPICK' BOOMS MIGRATE AROUND A PERIMETER TRACK TO PROVIDE DIVIDING SCREENS AND ADDITIONAL LIGHTING.
